

Boat Launch
 New boat launch area to provide access at West edge of park. Restrict vehicle traffic through park with boulders. Turnout radius enlarged for pull up and back in. Parallel parking for trailers at Riverside Street. Connect walkway to fountain. Provide two levels of pedestrian crossing at boat ramp.

Ravine Play
 Gazebo pavilion for groups of sixty. Gazebo to over look both ball diamond open space and new ravine play area. Ravine play area to be passive and encourage play on the earth forms, mounds, and valleys. Excavated areas of ravine used to create mounds and grade change. Boulder retaining walls, a suspension bridge, and at-grade concrete slide are possible amenities.

Park Entrance
 Park entrance to feature memorial space or sculpture space. Play areas not conducive to traffic on Clark Street without fencing. Added tree lined parking off Leland Avenue. Potential use of long narrow space to be tree allee on long axis with brick path. New tree allee could accommodate folding chair receptions, speeches, or musical performances. Bathrooms close by shown in yellow.

Lower Dam
 Kayak Rodeo Course
 Modified lower dam with boulders
 Features:
 Better fish habitat
 Safer outflow than present undercurrent
 Kayak recreation attraction
 Natural observation areas at both sides
 Entrance with more seating and access to river level

Bank Planting
 Extend trail at South side. Provide planting that screens views and opens views at strategic locations. Bury exposed concrete rip rap and expose only new boulder or natural limestone at both banks.

Trails End
 Enhance trails end with shortened Hawkins Road and addition of new ramp and "storm water fountain feature". See illustration. Route street storm water through rock formations.
